

## **CCTA Policy: Existing and New Services to Non-Members**

### I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to clarify how the funding of existing services and potential new services to non-members will be treated as of July 1, 2011. This policy is intended to recognize two situations:

- 1) Existing Green Mountain Transit Agency (GMTA) services are currently funded in a manner separate from the assessment formula applied to CCTA member municipalities, and
- 2) In the absence of a funding mechanism for rural services or services to non-members, the CCTA Board will need a process by which new services to non-members could be added if it were the Board's desire to do so.

### II. Background

As of July 1, 2011, CCTA will assume responsibility for the services previously operated by the GMTA. These services are operated in municipalities that are not members of CCTA and therefore, the existing CCTA assessment formula does not apply to the recipients of these services. Until such time as the CCTA assessment formula is amended or another mechanism to provide local funding for non-member services is created, a policy must be in place that addresses how services to non-members will be funded.

### III. Policy

#### Existing Services to Non-Members

Beginning on July 1, 2011, the CCTA Board of Commissioners accepts the current funding arrangements for existing services provided to non-members that had been previously approved by the GMTA Board of Directors. Existing services covered by this policy are listed in Attachment A.

#### New Services to Non-Members

Beginning on July 1, 2011, the CCTA Board of Commissioners will consider developing funding packages for services to non-members on a case-by-case basis. Approval to implement services to non-members according to such funding packages shall only be given by a majority vote of the CCTA Board of Commissioners.

Member Municipality Local Funds

No local funds raised through the property tax in CCTA member municipalities shall be used to fund services to non-members.
