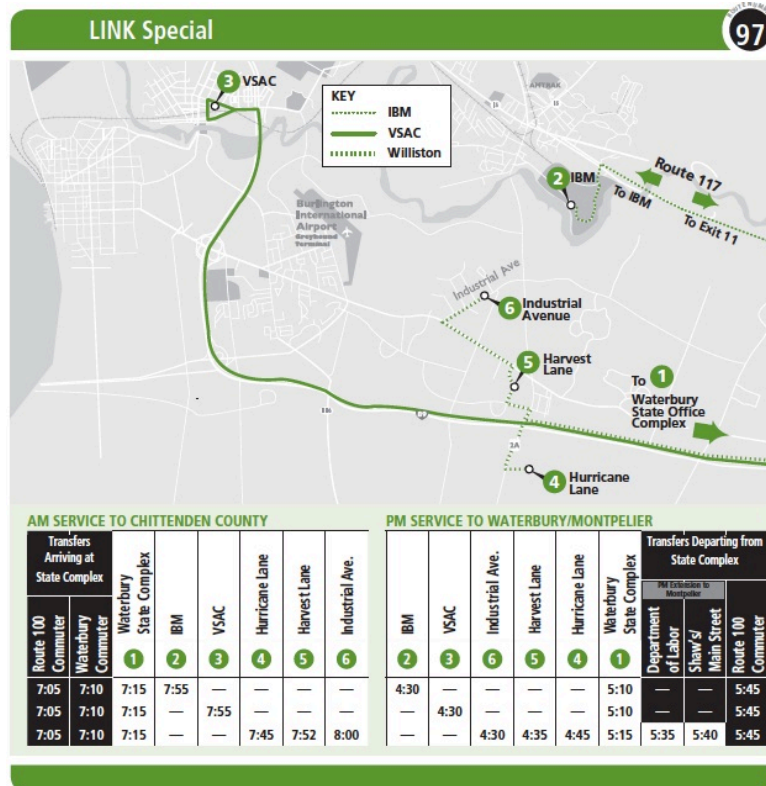
CCTA REVAMPS LINK SPECIAL SERVICE TO BETTER SERVE RELOCATED STATE EMPLOYEES STARTING JANUARY 9 2012

LINK SPECIAL Open to the General Public!

Burlington, VT (January 4, 2012) – The Chittenden County Transportation Authority (CCTA) is revamping the LINK SPECIAL to better serve the state employees relocated to offices in Chittenden County. The revised routes and schedule will begin on January 9 2012. The LINK SPECIAL provides transportation between the Waterbury State Complex and locations within Chittenden County acting as temporary office space for state employees displaced by Irene-related flooding.

The LINK SPECIAL is also open to the general public. The service is free to all through the end of January. On February 1 2012, the LINK SPECIAL will begin charging the regular LINK fare of \$4.00 per one-way trip. LINK 10-Rides and Monthly passes are available.

The morning trips will begin at the Waterbury State Complex at 7:15 AM. One bus will run express to IBM, one to VSAC, and the third bus will make stops at Hurricane Lane, Harvest Lane, and Industrial Avenue in Williston. The three return trips will depart IBM, VSAC, and Industrial Avenue at 4:30 PM. Passengers from IBM and VSAC will be able to transfer to the PM LINK Special bus from Williston at the Waterbury State Complex to continue to Montpelier. Please see the schedule below.
